Certified organic by CCOF, Vecino Vineyard lies North of Lake Mendocino and South of Lake Pillsbury.




## **Potter Valley AVA**

On the Eastern side of Mendocino County, Potter Valley sits at a higher elevation than it's surroundings and is influenced by the Eel River watershed creating cool growing conditions



## Sauvignon Blanc

Originally from Bordeaux, SB is herbally, grassy, and carries good acid. This, the Musque clone, tones some of that down with heightened aromatics.



The 2023 Potter Valley Sauvignon Blanc was harvested on Sept. 7th-8th at 20.4° brix. Grapes were whole cluster pressed and fermented in a stainless steel tank. Post-fermentation, malolactic was partially blocked. 10% Sauvignon Blanc from Larrick Vineyard in Dry Creek Valley was also used in the final blend.
