Tasting Notes

Cozy as a Christmas fire, cranberry and rhubarb dance on the palate as you're filled with the warmth of pie spice, followed by a silky finish. You can practically hear the crackling flames.


Winemaking

These grapes are sourced entirely from the Old Potrero Vineyard in Arroyo Grande Valley, which has a perfect plateau for these grapes. This old vine Zinfandel is located only 8 miles from the ocean, so the wine retains incredible acidity, even at riper levels. This block is entirely dry farmed in what is essentially beach sand with 10-by-10 spacing, evocative of Spain. This produces incredibly small yields. The grapes were hand-picked and 100% destemmed. We fermented for 3 weeks, then pressed off to barrel. We prefer to use American oak to counterbalance the brightness of the fruit.
